

## *Directions to CoRE Auditorium*

### ***From Route 18:***

- Follow Route 18 North (or West: signs differ, but mean the same) to New Brunswick.
- Proceed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Bridge.
- Take the first exit for Campus Road - Busch Campus.
- Follow this road through the various curves until the road turns into one lane. From here, you will come to a traffic circle. You will travel approx. 40 degrees around the circle and exit onto Bartholomew Road (the first exit you come to going through the circle).
- You will come to a four way stop sign at the intersection of Bartholomew and Brett Roads.
- Make a left at the 4-way stop sign on to Brett Road.
- Brett Road will go up a short hill then curve to the left. After the curve the road will straighten and you will come to a stop sign at the entrance to a parking lot. There is a sign at the entrance that identifies it as lot 64. The CoRE Building (seven story dark brown brick structure) will be on your right at far end of parking lot. Please park in lot 64.

### ***From Route 1 or NJ Turnpike (exit 9):***

- Exit onto Route 18 North and follow directions as above.

### ***From Route 287 Northbound or Southbound to:***

- Take Exit 9, River Road/Rte 514/Bound Brook/Highland Park exit.
- If you were traveling Northbound on I-287, turn left off ramp.
- If you were traveling Southbound on I-287, turn right off ramp.
- Proceed east on River Road toward Highland Park.
- Continue on River Road and you will pass under the overpass for Route 18. Make the next left onto Route 18 North.
- Proceed up Route 18 to the Campus Road exit ramp on the right.
- Follow Campus Road until you come to the traffic circle and take the first right off the circle onto Bartholomew Road.
- You will come to a four way stop sign at the intersection of Bartholomew and Brett Roads.
- Make a left at the 4-way stop sign on to Brett Road.
- Brett Road will go up a short hill then curve to the left. After the curve the road will straighten and you will come to a stop sign at the entrance to a parking lot. There is a sign at the entrance that identifies it as lot 64. The CoRE Building (seven story dark brown brick structure) will be on your right at far end of parking lot. Please park in lot 64.
